Work on demands in document management systems with **CONFLUENCE CONNECT**

THE CONFLUENCE CONNECT INTERFACE

When you're working on demand management in Can Do, the interface between the document management system Confluence Connect and Can Do enables you to create a project page in Confluence based on project data in Can Do.

A link to the project page is stored in Can Do, enabling you to open it in Confluence with just one click.

Everyone involved in the project can access and edit this page. You can also add more pages or tables of contents and manually link them to Can Do.

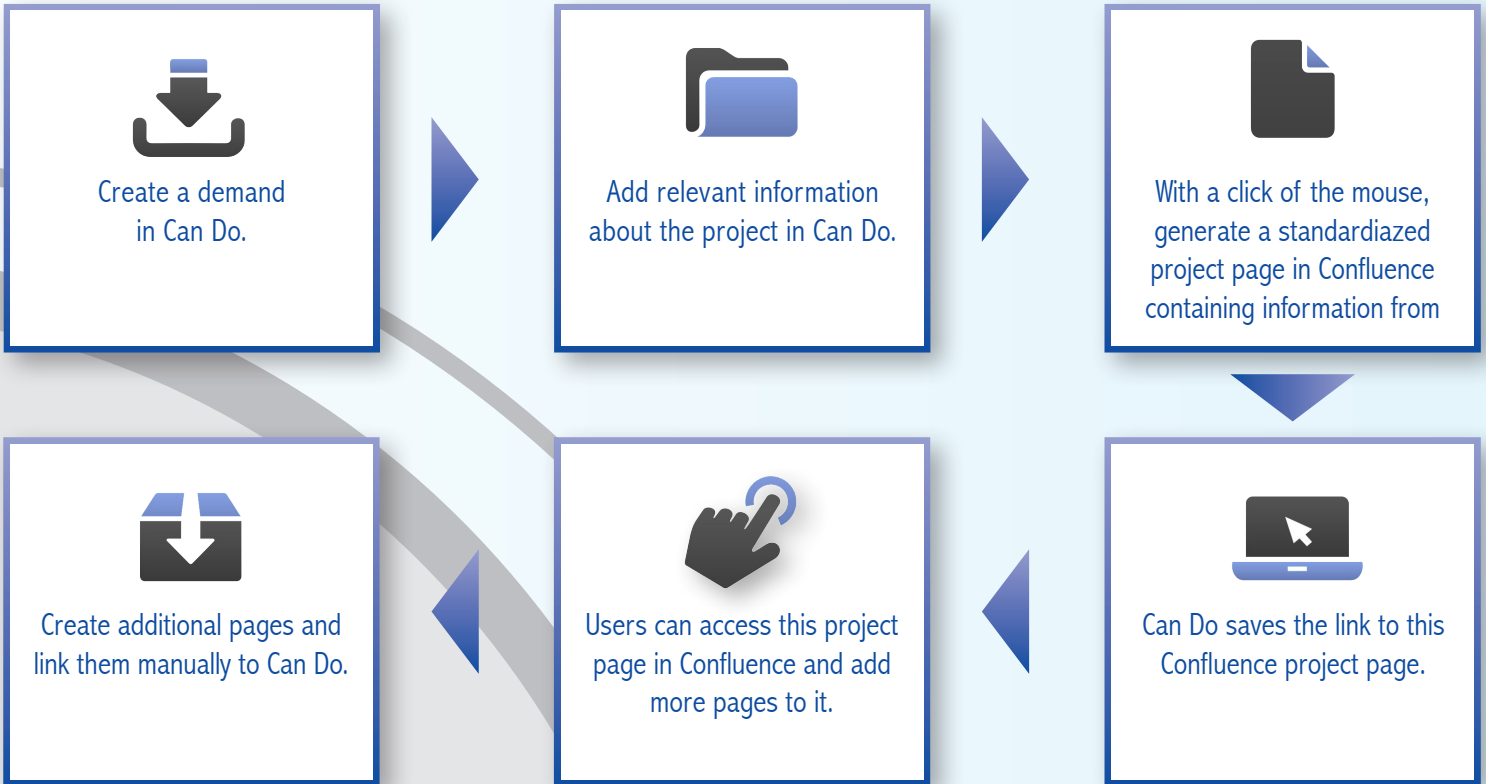
HOW DOES IT WORK?

You create a demand in Can Do and add the information you want in the project template, such as project number, requested deadline, contact person etc., and click to generate a page containing these details in the document management system Confluence.

In Confluence, you'll see the information contained in your project template. You can also add more pages or tables of contents and manually link them to Can Do.

PROJECT TEAMS BENEFIT FROM CONVENIENT DOCUMENT MANAGEMENT

Companies often use Atlassian's document management system to collaborate on project documents.

Once the demand has been created in the Can Do project management solution, the interface to Confluence Connect enables cross-departmental project teams with a range of team members (department and project managers, HR, finance etc.) to use the linked project page in Confluence.

It's a really elegant way of connecting the demand management and document management environments.
