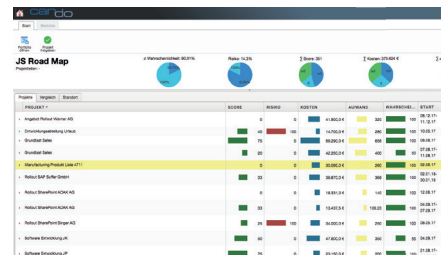

The Can Do Demand Management Suite is comprised of two parts that each have their own tiles. The person making the request has tiles to create demands and manage them, while

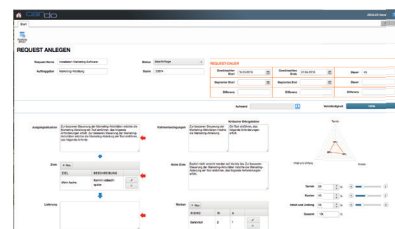
the recipient has access to these along with functions for checking the demands for completeness and for collecting, evaluating, accepting and refusing them.
